<b>Justification</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The proposed road connects Mining area to Kondli Cross (NH-206) to Byatappanapalya Major District Road (MDR) running through several villages.</li> <li>• It is severely damaged due to the frequent movement of Mining trucks transporting Ore to the Mangalore Port via Tiptur Hassan and Sakleshpur.</li> <li>• The upgradation of this road will benefit about 4416 people of 3 Mining affected villages.</li> </ul>
