They are connecting 8 directly Mining effected villages, and 4 villages nearby (about 5 km from Mining villages of Kenkere and Guruvapura) thereby benefitting 32,027 population. The inter villages roads will play a pivotal role in boosting the economic activities of the area. Since the villages are in Mining affected area, this project is proposed under CEPMIZ.
