Justification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> These roads are damaged due to movement of Mining trucks and are required to be re-constructed. They are connecting 12 directly Mining effected villages, and 1 village nearby (about 3 Km of Mining affected JC Pura village) thereby benefitting 23,209 population. Connectivity through these roads will foster economic activities in the areas as well provide greater connectivity to health and educational facilities. Since the villages are in Mining affected area, this project is proposed under CEPMIZ.
