<b>Justification</b>	Hospete Taluka is the hub of the iron ore mining and all the villages in the Taluka are badly affected by mining related activities. There are 96 Anganwadis presently in the Hospete Taluka which need to be strengthened and 114 new Anganwadis are required to be constructed to cover all the vulnerable population.
