Although these villages are not directly affected by mining, they are adjacent to mining affected areas and this road provides communication to mining vehicles and people of directly mining affected villages. Widening and strengthening of the road from Km 1.325 to 4.00 is proposed for funding under CEPMIZ due to scarcity of funds
