Justification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Animal Husbandry has suffered due to mining and transportation • Lack of sheep / Goat market in Sandur taluka - the local farmers have to go to nearby taluka for selling their animals. • The travelling/transportation is expensive and exhausts a major part of their income from animal sale. • Lack of Wool-processing facilities for value-addition activities for local shepherds.
