<b>Justification</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Animal Husbandry has suffered due to mining and transportation</li> <li>Lack of sheep / Goat market in Sandur taluka - the local farmers have to go to nearby taluka for selling their animals.</li> <li>The travelling/transportation is expensive and exhausts a major part of their income from animal sale.</li> <li>Lack of Wool-processing facilities for value-addition activities for local shepherds.</li> </ul>
