<b>Justification</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ballari is a Garment Hub, having more than 2000 garment units employing approx. 50,000 people.</li> <li>• An attrition rate of 10% is reported in these garment units.</li> <li>• Also, there is scope for establishing new garment industries and Apparel Park in the District.</li> <li>• Huge demand for skilled manpower in Apparel Sector is expected.</li> </ul> <p>Therefore, the project is proposed for funding from KMERC under CEP Miz.</p>
