Objective	<p>Total of about 135868 Ha of Land in Holalkere Taluk is cultivable land and out of which only 78812 Ha of Land is irrigated land comes out from Ground water.</p> <p>1) By constructing check dams nearby agricultural land i.e around 80 to 100 acres can utilise the water by means of indirect irrigation</p> <p>2) By Storage of water by means of check dams or by tanks improvements work the ground water table will rise.</p>

Justification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Due to mining, the ratio of Ground water is inversely decreasing resulting in decrease in depth of the water table. The construction of Check dam will improve soil fertility thereby increases land value.
