Justification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fish-Farming in Chitradurga has been adversely affected by the Mining activities in the area. • The proposed interventions will directly benefit approx. 60-70% fishermen and fishermen cooperatives across the Mining-affected villages of Chitradurga District, by helping them improve fish-production and increase their incomes. • Funds provided by State Govt. are not sufficient for undertaking the proposed works.
