<b>Output (s)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Upgradation and repair work of existing fish seed rearing farms – 3 Nos.</li> <li>Capacity building - 4500 farmers (Training for 2 days - 100/year - 3000 farmers, Training for 5 days 150/year - 1500 farmers)</li> <li>Stocking Advance size (70-80mm) fish fingerlings - 15.30 lakhs per year</li> <li>Providing Fishery requisites like fish nets coracle, life jacket life buoy, ice box, etc., to 1250 Fishermen</li> </ul>
<b>Justification</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fish-Farming in Chitradurga has been adversely affected by the Mining activities in the area.</li> <li>The proposed interventions will directly benefit approx. 60-70% fishermen and fishermen cooperatives across the Mining-affected villages of Chitradurga District, by helping them improve fish-production and increase their incomes.</li> <li>Funds provided by State Govt. are not sufficient for undertaking the proposed works.</li> </ul>
<b>Outcome (s) (Expected Measurable Benefits)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Increase in productivity of tank and ponds of mines affected area to national standard of 2500kg/ha.,</li> <li>Increase fish availability up to 5-6Kgs per capita</li> <li>Increase in rural employment through fisheries up to 1000 persons per annum</li> </ul>
