The preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for each project under CEP Miz would be done by the line Department / proposing Organization, internally or through some agency as per KTPP Act. The cost of preparation of DPRs, if required, shall be funded by the KMERC.

***A) The DPR to be submitted to KMERC should contain, among others, details such as:***

- I. Contents / Index
- II. Project at a Glance / Salient Features Executive Summary
- III. Introduction and Background
- IV. Project Objectives
- V. Proposed Interventions
- VI. Stakeholders and their roles and responsibilities
- VII. Project Outputs (Activities & Quantities)
- VIII. Envisaged Outcomes & Monitoring framework
- IX. General Abstract of Cost (AOC)
  - a. Capital Expenditure
  - b. Equipment & Machinery (if applicable)
  - c. Operational Expenditure (if applicable)
- X. Abstract Estimates / Data sheets for each model / unit of work
- XI. Maps / sketches, showing location of works
- XII. Project Schedule / Implementation Calendar
- XIII. Cost Schedule / Expenditure Schedule
- XIV. Post Implementation maintenance and Sustainability mechanism
- XV. Cost-Benefit Analysis, if applicable
- XVI. Institutional Mechanism for Project Governance and Management

***B) The Implementing Department / Agency shall certify as to the following:***

10. That post-implementation, sufficient funds and manpower for maintenance and sustainability will be ensured through the departmental budget / user fee / other means (Please specify).
11. That the Department will abide by the guidelines of the KMERC / State Govt, as communicated from time to time.

- ❖ The Implementing Department, as per the requirement, may take provision in the DPR, of a maximum of 1% of the Project Cost towards:
  - i. Administrative cost (both at State and District Level),
  - ii. Project Monitoring,
  - iii. Documentation &
  - iv. 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Evaluation
- ❖ The Line Department / Project Implementing Agency (PIA) may utilize the CEPMIZ funds for the preparation of the DPRs, as per the approved norms in the Department (Copy needs to be submitted), subject to KTPP Act.

If there are no approved norms in the Department, then the PIA will be permitted to spend up to 0.50% of the Project Cost (if the Project Cost is up to INR 10.00 Cr.) and 0.30 % of the Project Cost (if the Project Cost is more than INR 10.00 Cr.) as per the norms in the Minor Irrigation Dept., subject to KTPP Act.

A copy (both soft & hard) of the duly Technically scrutinized / sanctioned DPR / Detailed Estimate shall be made available to KMERC for its record and future use.

**D) DPR submission to KMERC:**

The DPRs containing details as per A) above but not containing detailed estimates, designs & drawings and rate analysis etc., are to be appraised by the KMERC & approved for implementation by the concerned line department / PIA.
