Furthermore, this initiative aligns with Karnataka's commitment to enhancing public health and adheres to the recommendations set forth by the World Health Organization (WHO). So, this proposal includes providing two doses for individuals aged 14, with the second dose administered 1 to 2 months after the first.</li> <li>• As HPV is a vaccine which is not a part of UIP and being introduced in Karnataka newly.
