A 5% annual increase in human resource support over the next three years will enhance long-term service reliability and help attract skilled healthcare professionals. This initiative will also alleviate the financial pressure of out-of-pocket medical expenses. Repurposing the existing hospital into a dedicated child and maternity care centre will help reduce the strain on the broader healthcare infrastructure. |

Improves the Maternal and child health by at least 30% in 5 years. Patient load at various hospitals of Sandur Taluk will reduce by 40% within 2 years. 45,000 Outpatients, and 8000 in patients are expected every year after 3 years. |
