Construction of CC road from Laxmipura near Seenabasappa camp to Harishankara MML office via Nandihalli PG Centre Road widening & Junction improvement in Sandur taluk from Km 0.00 to 7.10 (including land acquisition)</p> <p>2. Road Construction of CC road to bypass CC road to Ranjipura, Navalatti, Kammathur circle via NMDC township-Railway gate-Bhujanganagara bypass road from 0.00 to 6.95 in Sandur taluk (including land acquisition)</p> <p>3. Justification	<p>The proposed roads under the project of length 19.83 Km connect from mining roads to NH-67, SH-40 and MDRs. The existing road network is completely damaged and in a dilapidated condition resulting in slow movement of ore carrying vehicles.</p> <p>Movement of vehicles on earthen surface leads to production of dust, causing air pollution leading to unhealthy condition and crop damage.</p> <p>These roads are very important for the transportation of iron ores from- SMIORE, NMDC, BKG, RPCL, MSPL, Asha, Parvati mining quarries located near Devagiri, Kammathur villages. Further, they will be benefitting mining affected villages Laxmipura, Yashwathanagara, Seenabasappa Camp, Nandihalli, Nandihalli PG Centre and Vaddu village serving 6324 population.</p>

	<p>Several mining transport vehicles are passing through these villages resulting in accidents, pollution of water bodies and dust pollution due to which there were protests from villagers. Hence, this project is proposed.</p> <p>The State Government has not made any provision for improvements to this road in the budgetary allocation due to paucity of funds. Hence, this is proposed.</p>
